RECOMMENDATION

The Board of Directors:

1. Approve the following quotes for the implementation of the Radio Replacement Project:

- a. Motorola: \$75,704 (VHF consolettes, VHF transmitters, portable radios)
- b. Vision Communications: \$152,106.84 (VHF consolettes, VHF transmitters)
- c. WestNet: \$9,164.66 (CAD system integration consolettes and transmitters)
- d. Testforce: \$36,269 (spectrum analyzer)
- e. CDCE, Inc: \$8,824.47 (programming laptops)
- f. Raven Electronics: \$4,295 (audio bridge for transmitters)

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

The Center received approval from Sac OES to reallocate SHSGP20 Grant funding to complete a Regional Radio Replacement Project to replace aging and outdated hardware, maintain operational capability, and address current system vulnerabilities. The Center is in receipt of the quotes described below to implement the project.

<u>Motorola</u>: Quotes have been received totaling \$75,704 for the replacement of VHF consolettes, transmitters, and portable radios.

In accordance with the Board Policy 3.017 – Procurement, while this project is over \$50,000 and would typically require an RFP or RFB, this contract may be awarded without formal bidding based on the following exemption: the supplies, materials, services, or equipment are produced only by one manufacturer or are available only from one source.

Motorola equipment is required for 800MHz and VHF radio communications within Sacramento County as the County operates on a Motorola-based radio system. The quote provided by Motorola utilizes an existing open contract with the County in order to obtain the required equipment.

<u>Vision Communications</u>: Quotes have been received totaling \$152,106.84 for the replacement of VHF consolettes and transmitters with simulcast capability.

In accordance with the Board Policy 3.017 – Procurement, while this project is over \$50,000 and would typically require an RFP or RFB, this contract may be awarded without formal bidding based on the following exemption: the supplies, materials, services, or equipment are produced only by one manufacturer or are available only from one source.

Staff Report: Regional Radio Hardware Upgrade, Report 22-29

While the County operates on a Motorola-based radio system, Motorola doesn't offer simulcast capabilities. Simulcast capabilities are currently integrated into the regional system through Vision Communications.

<u>WestNet</u>: Quotes have been received totaling \$9,164.66 for the CAD system integrations of the VHF consolettes and transmitters.

In accordance with the Board Policy 3.017 – Procurement, due to the high degree of professional or technical skill of the services provided, professional services are exempt from the bidding process and selection shall be based on demonstrated competence and on the professional qualifications necessary for the satisfactory performance of the services required. While this procurement is exempted from bidding requirements by the Center's policy, it is considered a small purchase according to federal grant guidelines and therefore required an adequate number of quotes via an informal bidding process. No other quotes were obtained for these services, however, as WestNet is the sole and exclusive provider of such services for integration into the CAD system.

<u>Testforce</u>: A quote has been received totaling \$36,269 for the spectrum analyzer equipment.

In accordance with the Board Policy 3.017 – Procurement, the purchase of tangible personal property between \$5,000 - \$50,000 requires an informal bidding process by which three (3) quotes must be obtained. As such, three (3) quotes were obtained from Testforce, DVTest, and VIAVI Solutions. Testforce provided the lowest quote.

CDCE, Inc.: A quote has been received totaling \$8,824.47 for programming laptops.

In accordance with the Board Policy 3.017 – Procurement, the purchase of tangible personal property between \$5,000 - \$50,000 requires an informal bidding process by which three (3) quotes must be obtained. However, this contract may be awarded without additional quotes based on the following exception:

 Property or services provided by or through other governmental agencies; or obtainable from suppliers which have in force a current contract with another governmental agency for the same item or service.

The Center has confirmed that CDCE, Inc. is under NASPO Master Agreement MNWNC-124 for like services with comparable competitive pricing

Raven Electronics: A quote has been received totaling \$4,295 for audio bridges for the VHF transmitters.

In accordance with the Board Policy 3.017 – Procurement, the purchase of tangible personal property under \$5,000 does not require shopping or bidding thought 3 quotes are encouraged. No other quotes were obtained for these goods, however, the quote from Raven Electronics is in line with known industry standards for like products.

FINANCIAL ANALYSIS

The total cost for implementing the Radio Replacement Project as described above is \$286,363.97. \$281,750 will be funded through the SHSGP20 grant award and \$4,613.97 will be funded through a transfer to the Grant Account from the Operating Account.
